Dear parents and legal guardians:

Re: Requirements for Travellers Within and Outside Canada

With the reopening of the borders, it is our duty to inform you of the most recent Government of Canada emergency measures under *the Quarantine Act* to slow the introduction and spread of COVID-19 and its variants in Canada, more specifically unvaccinated children less than 12 years of age who enter Canada.

If your travel is **within Canada**, be aware of the [Travel and Self-isolation Requirements](#) for all individuals returning to Manitoba. For further information, see [Self-isolation \(Quarantine\) for Asymptomatic Returning Travellers](#) and [Testing for Travellers](#).

For domestic travellers, if you are fully immunized and two weeks have passed since your last dose at the time of your arrival, you are exempt from needing to self-isolate (quarantine) under the provincial travel order. Domestic travel exemptions include children under the age of 12, if all individuals they travelled with are fully immunized.

If your travel is **outside of Canada**, the [Government of Canada guidance](#) applies. International travelers MUST follow federal self-isolation (quarantine) [requirements](#).

Note that [unvaccinated children under the age of 12 without symptoms and traveling with fully vaccinated parents or guardians](#) cannot attend school, camp or daycare (among other activities) for 14 days upon return to Canada.
