

# WHEN CAN A SICK CHILD RETURN TO SCHOOL?

## What happens if a student has symptoms at school?

Isolate the student in a separate room and keep the student at least two meters away from others. Ensure the student and staff member is wearing a mask. Notify parent / guardian to pick up the child immediately. Ask the parent / guardian to contact Health Links / Info Santé. If your child goes for a test and it's negative, they can return after 24 hours of being symptom free. If your child did not get tested, they should isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms and may return if symptoms have resolved by that time.



## What happens if a family member living in the same household displays COVID-19 symptoms?

**Effective Nov. 9, 2020:** If anyone in your household is symptomatic, the entire household must self-isolate at home. This applies ALL of the SRSD Schools.

If a family member tests positive, the child would become a close contact and would need to stay home and isolate with their family for 14 days.
