Summer Literacy Camp Facilitator – In this capacity, you will work with children between the ages of 6 – 8 to help them maintain and improve their literacy skills through reading, activities and various literacy games. In this capacity you will work 6.0 hours per day (weekdays) until June 28, 2019 and 8.0 hours per day until August 16, 2019.

The successful candidates will possess the following qualifications:

- The ideal candidate will be pursuing or interested in pursuing a career in Education or in Early Childhood Education
- Previous related experience working with young children in a child-care setting is considered an asset;
- Must have excellent organizational and behaviour management skills;
- Must communicate effectively with children and parents;
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and as part of a team;
- Valid driver's license and use of personal vehicle is required for travel to/from our various sites;
- Given the grant requirements funding these programs, applicants must be between the ages of 18 and 29.
- Additionally, consideration will be given to applicants who are of Indigenous descent, visible minority or a person with disability. As such, applicants are invited to self-declare in their cover letter if they are part of one of these designated groups.
