REGULATION: IGAK BASIC FRENCH

EXHIBIT:

Basic French

The Basic French program is compulsory at the K-8 grade levels for students registered in the English Program. Exception may be made for students who are on an Individualized Educational Plan and if it is deemed in the student's best interest by the school staff.

At the Grade 9 to 12 levels, the Basic French option must be listed annually on the course selection material. The decision to offer it is contingent on a reasonable number of students electing to take the course. The school must ensure that the school is flexibly staffed to offer the program should numbers warrant.

1. There must be support for Professional Development in the area of teaching Basic French at the school and divisional levels.
2. Consideration of Basic French when hiring.
3. Consideration of the itinerant model when necessary to ensure quality of the Basic French Program.
