S.I.C. and S.I.P. Options / Summer School Credits

**1. School Initiated Courses and Student Initiated Projects**

The complete requirements for the development, implementation, and registration of SICs and SIPs are described in the handbook: **LOCALLY DEVELOPED CURRICULA: School-initiated Courses and Student-initiated Projects:**

In part, this handbook contains:

- The forms to be used for registering SICs and SIPs
- A requirement that the school-initiated course plan follow a framework format similar to Manitoba Education, Training and Youth curricula
- A requirement that the course designation and course numbering be consistent with *Renewing Education: New Directions The Action Plan*
- A requirement that student marks be reported as percentages

The maximum number of SIC credits allowable in the calculation of a student's Senior Years graduation credit requirements is eight (8) credits (i.e. 8 credits across Senior 1-4).

The maximum number of SIP credits allowable in the calculation of a student's Senior Years graduation credit requirements is two (2) credits (i.e. 2 credits across Senior 1-4).

SICs and SIPs may not be used to meet compulsory core graduation requirements.

All S.I. courses must be approved by the Assistant Superintendent (Instruction) before becoming part of the school's program. A detailed course plan for each newly developed course must be forwarded to this office two months before implementation.
