EXHIBIT:

Tuition Fees for Independent Study Courses/Summer Courses

Tuition fees for independent study, online and summer courses may be reimbursed from a school's budget to high school students who could not take a course because of timetable conflicts. Tuition fees for such courses shall be reimbursed only if:

- a) requests for such courses have been approved in advanced by the principal;
- b) the student has submitted a copy of the receipt for the tuition fees, and;
- c) the student has obtained standing in the course.
- d) A medical certificate is provided in cases of illness;
- e) the student is registered in one of our schools.

N.B. - The division does not pay for home tutoring.

- As a pilot project and for the 2001-02 school year only the school division will pay the tuition for up to five online courses per high school upon successful completion by the student.

Tuition Fees – Distance Education

The breakdown of responsibility for payment of registered fees is as follows:

Student	-	25%
School	-	25%
Division	-	50%
