REGULATION: JECBA ADMISSION FOREIGN STUDENTS

EXHIBIT:

Foreign pupils:

1. Full time students, only, will be accepted. The entry date for schools on an annual system shall not be later than November 15<sup>th</sup>. For schools on a semester system, the entry date shall be not later than October 10<sup>th</sup>.
2. The non-resident fee to be paid is set annually by the School Board, and will be prorated by any eligible provincial funding. The fee for a late entry would be pro-rated on a per month basis, and would include the month during which the student was registered. Refund of fees paid will not be made if students withdraw. Under exceptional circumstances only, may the Board consider granting a refund.
3. The maximum number of foreign students that may be accepted at each school will be determined by the principal. The maximum should be such that the physical space and resources are not put at a premium for the resident students.
4. The schools or the school division will not compensate individuals acting as agents for the placement of foreign pupils.
5. The students/applicants shall acknowledge receipt/acceptance of these conditions in writing.
6. The student must meet the Manitoba Education Immunization requirements before being accepted into the school.
