**REGULATION: JH – STUDENT WELFARE – MISSING CHILDREN**

**EXHIBIT:**

Increasingly, authorities are being asked to assist in locating children abducted by non-custodial parents or other persons. Addressing this problem requires close co-operation of various agencies. School Boards are a vital part of this multi-disciplinary approach.

Seine River School Division endorses the following guidelines pertaining to abducted students:

1. Upon registering a child in a school, the parent shall provide the name and address of the school the child attended previously.
2. The principal shall contact the previous school by telephone to obtain information and request the cumulative files on the child (principal may confirm later in writing).
3. If no records are received or available from the school named by the parent, the principal shall contact the police.
