



POLICY:

REGULATION: KK VISITORS TO SCHOOLS

EXHIBIT:

Unauthorized Visitors:

They shall be asked to leave the school grounds. If they refuse, they shall be asked second time, and cautioned that they might be reported to the police for trespassing.

Trespassers and Disturbances:

As summarized by Manitoba Education, Education Administration Services.

Legislative References:

The Public Schools Act, Section 231

Principal Responsibilities:

No one shall disturb or interrupt a school, class or school activity on or near school premises. No one shall trespass on school premises.

A principal may direct a person to leave school premises if that person:

- is disruptive,
- trespasses, or
- has no school related reason for being on the premises.

The offending party must leave immediately upon being asked by the principal and may not return until he or she has received permission to re-enter school property.

The principal may obtain assistance from the police if force is required to remove the disruptive person from school premises or if this would help to maintain order on school premises.

Trespassers and other disruptive people are subject to a maximum fine of \$ 5,000.

In addition to the fine, the offending party may be permanently banned from the premises, made to comply with other measures that the court deems to be appropriate or may be subject to other legal remedies. (231(7) under review.)
