Seine River School Division is a smoke free environment. Out of consideration for the health and well-being of students, staff, parents and community members, smoking is prohibited on all school division property, including all buildings, grounds and school division vehicles; and at school sponsored or school-supervised events outside the school division.

We encourage all adults and students to refrain from smoking within sight of school division property.

In addition to smoking, medical evidence clearly shows that scented products are harmful to the health of sensitive individuals. In sufficient concentrations scented products may be harmful to those with allergies, environmental sensitivity or chronic heart or lung disease. In considering the health needs and concerns of those sensitive and non-sensitive employees alike and to provide a healthy working environment for every employee, Seine River School Division encourages all staff, students and visitors to school division buildings to comply with the scent-free policy and regulations.
