Seine River School Division promotes a safe, caring and positive environment for everyone within schools and on school buses, in accordance with its Mission Statement and statement of beliefs.

The expectations for behaviour on school buses, the consequences and processes for managing behaviour of students while riding buses, correspond with the general intent and processes of the School Codes of Conduct.

Consequences for inappropriate behaviour should be based on individual needs, the degree of the problem and the ability of the person to understand and handle the consequences.

In accordance with the Manitoba Regulation 465/88 of the Public Schools Act (Pupil Conduct While Being Transported):

Section 13(1) "The principal of a school whose pupils are being transported on the school bus has disciplinary authority over the conduct of the pupils when the pupil is in, entering upon or alighting from the school bus."

Section 13 (3) "The driver of a school bus shall report to the principal any misconduct of children while entering, leaving, or being conveyed in a vehicle under his/her charge."
