EXHIBIT:

The Board endorses the concept that school buses should be primary mode of transportation for school – related activities.

A school principal may authorize the use of a private vehicle for transporting students to school – related activities when the number of students is such that it is not feasible to utilize a school bus (20 or fewer students).

The owner of the vehicle may be reimbursed at the rate no more than the divisional rate. The principal shall be responsible for determining the fee for each trip.
