The Board of Trustees of SRSD recognizes the value and benefits of learning additional languages and as such promotes opportunities for its students to acquire French as a means of communication.

The Seine River School Division offers a French Immersion Program to parallel the regular English Program in structure and content as established by the Province of Manitoba. The goal of the French Immersion Program is to provide the opportunity for students to become bilingual in English and French. In the French Immersion Program, the target language is taught not only as a subject but is also used as the language of instruction in other subjects. Also, the immersion approach promotes an appreciation of the French peoples and their cultural diversity in Canada and in other regions of the world.

The Division provides continuous program from Kindergarten to Grade Twelve in a French milieu environment.
