



POLICY: ICC – SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS/Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry

REGULATION:

EXHIBIT:

The School Division has the responsibility of ensuring that all individuals wishing to work with students on a voluntary basis do not present a risk of physical or sexual abuse to students and are clear of pertinent criminal charges deemed problematic by the school division. A volunteer refers to any person, other than an employee, who offers his/her services freely to support students and teachers in a variety of school settings.

Understanding the need for a proper balance between the rights and privacy of volunteers, and protecting students from physical or sexual abuse, the School Division will request a check of the Provincial Child Abuse Registry and a Criminal Record Check where appropriate.

The policy will apply to all volunteers in the school division. For the protection of all students in our schools, it is to be understood that procedures pertaining to accepting volunteers will consider the regulations established by the Seine River School Division.
