



**POLICY: JFC - SAFE SCHOOL COMMUNITIES**

REGULATION:

EXHIBIT:

All employees, students, visitors and volunteers of the Seine River School Division are entitled to an environment that is supportive of their personal health, safety and well-being.

All employees, students, visitors and volunteers have the responsibility to act appropriately to maintain an environment that is free from physical violence, verbal, psychological and emotional abuse and threat of physical assault.

The **School Division** has the responsibility to:

- a) delegate to teachers and administrators, the authority to maintain order and discipline in the school and on school property as prescribed in the Public Schools Act and its subsequent regulations;
- b) ensure the establishment of programs and supports designed to help employees and students in the practice of preventative measures regarding inappropriate behavior;
- c) when an incident occurs ensure that an appropriate response is given to all parties involved.

This policy shall be reviewed every three (3) years by an ad hoc committee of the Seine River Teachers' Association and the Seine River School Division for the purpose of making recommendations to the Board of Trustees.
