REGULATION:

EXHIBIT:

Seine River School Division recognizes the use and abuse of certain substances interferes with student success both academic and in extracurricular involvement. The use and abuse of any tobacco products, inhalants (e-cigarettes, vaporizers or other similar products), alcohol, illicit or non-medical drugs, and controlled substances impacts negatively on the health and wellbeing of students, their engagement with learning and ultimately their ability to function well in society.

Seine River School division prohibits the use, possession or distribution of these items on all school division property and at school division or school-sanctioned activities or events.

Seine River School Division support students' learning of the dangers of these substances through education, early intervention and disciplinary action where required. Students who are in possession and/or traffic illegal substances are subject to the rules of the school division and laws and regulations of the province of Manitoba.
