Seine River School Division believes that it is everyone's legal obligation to protect children. This responsibility involves identifying and reporting a child whose life, health or emotional well-being is endangered by an act or an omission of a person. (Child and Family Services Act and Revised Manitoba Guidelines on Identification and Reporting a Child in Need of Protection (including Child Abuse); September 2001)

Principals shall ensure that all members of their staffs are informed and prepared to identify and report children in need of protection.
