Seine River School Division is committed to meeting the educational needs of all students. In order to meet the diverse needs of students, a continuum of supports, including health care services, has been developed.

- Seine River School Division endorses and supports the guidelines and procedures outlined in the provincial Unified Referral and Intake Systems Manual (URIS). Plans for students with Level A or B health needs, will follow the URIS procedures.
- Seine River School Division acknowledges that certain students may require administration of prescribed medication during the school day. Administration of medication is subject to the conditions outlined in Regulation JHCD - Administration of Medication to Students.
- Seine River School Division has developed Regulation JHCF – Anaphylaxis, which incorporates procedures from the Unified Referral and Intake Systems (URIS) and the Canadian School Boards Association for students with known risk of anaphylaxis and/or life threatening allergies. This regulation contains information and awareness, avoidance and emergency response.
