The Division believes that the primary goal of fund-raising conducted by schools and parent organizations on behalf of the Division's schools is to benefit the students of those schools and that fundraising activities can promote respectful partnerships between the home, the school and the community if such activities occurs with appropriate consideration for:

- student safety and respect for all participants in the activities
- the responsibilities of the public education system
- ethical and responsible practices
- the circumstances of individual school communities, students and their families
- clear statements to a school community about the fundraising activities' purpose

The Division recognize two types of fundraising activities: **Fundraising activities organized by the school** and **Fundraising activities organized by the Parent Advisory Council**

The Division endorses fundraising activities to enhance school programs and/or extra-curricular activities. Fundraising activities should give honest and fair return to those who purchase these products or services, should not demean students or staff, and should not unduly burden the community.

The Division recognizes that schools may wish to supplement their budgets for school-related (special projects, school activities, charitable causes) student activities through public fundraising.

Fundraising planning will include consultation with school community councils, parent advisory councils, staff and, where appropriate, the student council.

All fundraising activities for school programs, extra-curricular activities or for donations to outside agencies require prior approval of the school principal.
