Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

In anticipation of Oral Reporting on **November 25th from 4:00-7:00 pm (K-8)** and **November 26th from 8:30-11:30 am (K-8)** and **November 26th from 12:30-3:10 for Kindergarten ONLY**, it is important we share the current Public Health and Divisional guidelines, to ensure the appointments go as smoothly as possible. Please read the following information carefully and if you have any questions please contact your child's teacher or the school office.

You will receive an email from your child's teacher to book a 10-minute appointment over the phone, via Teams or in person. If you choose to meet via phone or Teams, the teacher(s) will contact you at your scheduled time.

If you choose to have an in-person appointment, each appointment will run for 10 minutes, with a 5-minute buffer in between appointments to allow the teachers to sanitize the meeting area prior to the arrival of the next parent. We thank you in advance for adhering to the time limit of your child's appointment.

All visitors to the school must wear a mask and hand sanitize upon arrival. There will be a door attendant to greet you and review the self-screening questions with you prior to your entry into the school. Reviewing the self-screening questions prior to your arrival will help move the process along more quickly.

Entry to the building will be restricted to those with an appointment at that specific time; there will be no early entry.

Please note the specific Cohort Door you need to use for each of your appointment(s):

Kindergarten-Kindergarten door on Normandeau Bay (regular drop-off & pick-up door)

Grade 1/2 Classes-Main school door closest to the office on Normandeau Bay

Grade 3/4 Classes-Door along Principale Street by the electronic sign

Grade 5/6 and 7/8 Classes-MY Door towards the far end of the bus loop

If you have appointments which are back to back, you may proceed from one to the next from inside the school. IF there is a break in time from one appointment to the next, you will need to exit the school and re-enter through the appropriate cohort door for your next appointment at your next scheduled time.

It is strongly encouraged that you attend with the fewest number of family members as possible to help us minimize contacts once you arrive at the school. Any children in attendance with their parent must remain with the parent from arrival to departure.

We recognize this is not the format we are all used to however to ensure everyone's safety & health, and to meet Public Health and Divisional requirements this is the format under which we are able to operate at this time. Thank you again for your ongoing support and patience as we continue to adjust. We look forward to discussing your child's progress with you, in which ever format is most convenient to you!
