- ⇒ demonstrate basic respect (ie: good manners) for themselves and others

At Parc La Salle, we believe that children learn self-discipline through the process of:

**Becoming aware of values, rights and responsibilities, managing daily conflicts, and learning limits of acceptable behavior and consequences.**

The goal of student self discipline is attained more readily with ongoing communication, co-operation and respect between parents, students and staff.

## BASIC SCHOOL WIDE RULES

1. **Keep Hands, Feet and unkind words to myself.**
2. **Follow instructions of all staff, first time given.**
3. **Listen when others are speaking.**

### MINOR OFFENCES

Violation of school wide rules

### MAJOR OFFENCES

1. Abuse towards a fellow student (\*verbal, physical, vandalism)
2. Abuse towards a staff member
3. Severe disruption (Physical or verbal) that will not allow the activity to continue safely or will not allow the class to continue learning
4. Non-compliance
  - \*\* Racist and/or prejudicial incidents:
    - A. Racist incidents are any behaviors, intentional or non intentional, which are meant to exclude or insult members of any participating group. These incidents will be dealt with as major offences.
    - B. Our primary concerns are to support the victim and to inform/educate the offender of the inappropriateness of his/her behavior.

Teach rights and responsibilities through modeling and direct instruction.</li> </ul>
<b>RESPECT FOR DIVISIONAL STAFF</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ Respect all school staff, division staff, and adult workers and volunteers in the school by listening, following instructions, cleaning up after yourself, and following the school rules.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ Encourage in your child a respect for the school and an understanding of its policies.</li> <li>⇒ Be a supportive role model by you, yourself showing respect for school staff and school rules.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ Respect the policies of the school and the division.</li> <li>⇒ Be appropriate role models by being encouraging and supportive.</li> <li>⇒ Respect the fundamental right of all people.</li> </ul>
<b>RESPECT FOR PROPERTY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ Take care of your personal property and of school property.</li> <li>⇒ Respect the property and personal space of others. <b><u>Take pride in your school!</u></b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ Foster in your child, the value of respect for school property and personal property.</li> <li>⇒ Ensure that your child understands the importance of making restitution and assist your child when necessary.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ Strive to provide a physical environment free from harm.</li> <li>⇒ Teach and encourage students to take responsibility for their property and for the property of others.</li> </ul>
