The Rehabilitation Assistant will be working under the direction of Speech and Language Pathologists and Occupational Therapists. The Rehabilitation Assistant implements intervention programs, working directly on the student specific skills. Responsibilities will include phonemic awareness, sensory processing, executive functioning, motor skills and assistive technology. Role may include education and training, documentation, goal monitoring, equipment management and collaboration with the school team. The Rehabilitation Assistant caseload will be varied and will include multiple schools.

Qualifications:

- Computer literacy as appropriate to the setting
- Must be proficient in both oral and written English communication
- Excellent interpersonal skills with people in variety of settings
- Physical Requirements
 - Must be in excellent physical and mental health
 - Must be able to stand, walk or sit for extended periods of time without resting
 - Must demonstrate the use of safe and effective body mechanics while working with students
 - Must be capable of bending, stretching and lifting while performing student duties
 - Must be able to safely transfer students who have limited or no weight bearing capabilities
 - Must demonstrate adequate strength, motor coordination, agility, and dexterity for implementation of therapeutic techniques

Education (Degree/Diploma/Certificate):

- Successful completion of a recognized academic Rehabilitation Assistant Program (not limited but including the Manitoba Institute of Trades and a Technology Rehabilitation Assistant Program or CDI) is preferred.
- Consideration will be given to applicants who have had two years or more of related experience in a similar role.
- Consideration may be given to individuals who are in the process of attaining degree in Occupational Therapy (OT) or those who have attained academic standing in OT and are eligible for licensure Work in consultation with the Student Services Coordinator.
