 - Develops culturally appropriate and inclusive programming; plans for and supports diverse needs and abilities.
 - Fosters a play-based approach and creates and maintains the classroom environment
 - Collaborates with divisional ECE Program Coordinator, school administrators, kindergarten teacher, and school/divisional learning support teams.
 - Develops materials and shops for supplies as required.
 - Completes daily observations on students including programming needs, strengths, and interests.
 - Documents student learning.
 - Attends Collaborative Program Meetings (School Based and Division Based).
 - Takes part in professional development.
 - Communicates with caregivers.
 - Directs assistant as required.

- Early Childhood Education Diploma Level 2 or 3 is required
 - Knowledge of child development, emergent curriculum, and play based approach to pedagogy.
 - Ability to work independently and as part of a team
 - Excellent organizational and classroom management skills
