## Responsibilities:

- Monitor students while on bus; maintains safety and order on the bus, ensure students wear seatbelts
- Assist with loading and unloading of students on /off the bus; provides special assistance to students in wheelchairs, including strapping and securing wheelchairs on vehicle
- Providing assistance with the wheelchair hydraulic lift when required.
- Provides assistance during emergencies, evacuation planning and drills; provides knowledge and operates emergency window exits.
- Maintains confidentiality

## **Qualifications:**

- Must be able to handle sensitive and confidential information
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills with students and adults
- Knowledge and understanding of the proper use of child restraints systems used for transporting students with special needs
- Ability to assist students with patience and understanding
