Costing of Possible Reductions: K-4 Bussing Summary

026/2024 K-4 Bussing Beyond Provincial Funding (between .8 and 1.6 km from school)

Bloomfield - Kiansky

WHEREAS, SRSD has been transporting K-4 children, non-eligible for Provincial funding, between .8 and 1.6 km from school for many years.

WHEREAS SRSD historically instituted this bussing for the safety and well-being of our youngest and most vulnerable children. In many of our communities, children must cross major roadways, highways, railroad tracks, etc. to get to school, many of those major safety hazards continue to exist today.

WHEREAS SRSD is currently facing significant financial challenges and a potential \$5.0M deficit, we can no longer continue bussing non-funded students at no cost.

THAT, effective the 2024-25 school year, families be immediately notified that children in Grades K-4, living between .8 and 1.6 km from school, who require transportation to and from school will be assessed an annual fee of \$500 per household, equating to a potential cost recovery revenue source for SRSD of \$150,000.
